You have been, or are suspected of having been, infected with Chlamydia

Chlamydia is a bacterium that is transmitted through sexual contact. Chlamydia is often asymptomatic but can sometimes cause discharge and a burning sensation from the urethra. The infection can spread to the testicles in men and to the fallopian tubes in women which can make it difficult to get pregnant. Chlamydia can be treated with antibiotics (tablets). We have been informed that you may be infected with chlamydia and because of that you must be tested according to the Swedish Communicable Diseases Act.

Samples will be taken from your urine, vagina, or rectum, depending on how you have had sex. Please contact a youth guidance centre (ungdomsmottagning) or healthcare centre (hälsocentral) and book an appointment. Everything during the visit is kept confidential.

Testing and antibiotic treatment are free of charge. If you already have been tested, please call the phone number below to inform us.

You need to

- get tested within two weeks.
- bring this letter with you to the clinic.

If you have sex before you get the test result you must tell the person you have sex with that you may have chlamydia. You also must use protection (condom or similar protection).
