Reminder

You have been, or are suspected of having been, infected with Chlamydia.

We contacted you on _____ but have not yet received confirmation that you have been tested.

According to the Swedish Communicable Diseases Act, you are obliged to get tested. If you do not do so within two weeks, a report will be filed to the County Medical Officer.

Please contact a youth guidance centre (ungdomsmottagning) or healthcare centre (hälsocentral) and book an appointment for testing. Samples will be taken from your urine, vagina or rectum depending on how you have had sex. Everything during the visit is kept confidential.

Chlamydia is a bacterium that is transmitted through sexual contact. Chlamydia is often asymptomatic but can sometimes cause discharge and a burning sensation from the urethra. The infection can spread to the testicles in men and to the fallopian tubes in women which can make it difficult to get pregnant. Chlamydia can be treated with antibiotic (tablets). Testing and antibiotic treatment are free of charge. If you already have been tested, please call the phone number below to inform us. You can also fill in this form yourself and send it to the address below. We will follow up that you have been tested.

If you have sex before you get the test result you must inform the person you have sex with that you may have chlamydia. You also must use protection (condom or similar protection).

Remember to bring this letter to the clinic.
